A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING POLICE CHIEF INSPECTOR RYAN LOPEZ MANONGDO OF DAGUPAN CITY, ONE OF THE COPS (COUNTRY'S OUTSTANDING POLICE OFFICERS IN SERVICE) AWARDEES FOR 2016, BY THE METROBANK FOUNDATION (MBFI), THE ROTARY CLUB OF NEW MANILA EAST (RCNME) AND THE PHILIPPINE SAVINGS BANK (PSBANK)

WHEREAS, Police Chief Inspector Ryan Lopez Manongdo, who was born, raised and educated in Dagupan City is a highly respected police officer, and has been chosen by the Metrobank Foundation Inc. (MBFI), the Rotary Club of New Manila East (RCNME) and the Philippine Savings Bank (PSBank) as one of the COPS (Country's Outstanding Police Officers In Service) for 2016;

WHEREAS, Police Chief Inspector Ryan Lopez Manongdo strived very hard to get a good education despite the meager income of his family from a small canteen. He earned his degree in Bachelor of Science in Education at Saint Louis University, Baguio City through CHED Scholarship Program, and a bachelor's degree in Public Safety at the Philippine National Police Academy in Silang, Cavite. To satiate his thirst for more knowledge, he took up Bachelor of Laws at the University of Pangasinan with 30 units and earned his Master's degree in Public Administration at the University of La Salle in Santiago City, Isabela. His academic pursuit paid off when he passed several government examinations, to wit: NAPOLCOM PESE (2nd placer); NAPOLCOM Superintendent Exam (8th placer); and NAPOLCOM Inspector Exam (3rd placer);

WHEREAS, in 2009, Police Chief Inspector Ryan Lopez Manongdo, using inflatable beds, led the rescue of 130 people from flood brought by Typhoon Pepeng. For this extraordinary accomplishment, he was awarded as an "Eat Bulaga Hero" during the 30th anniversary celebration of the noontime show on December 12, 2009 ;

WHEREAS, Police Chief Inspector Ryan Lopez Manongdo as then Chief of Police of Pozorrubio had successfully rallied the whole community to prevent crime. Among the programs that he implemented were:

- (1) LAMBAT-Localized Anti-crime Movements Based on Actual Tally, repelling the opportunity of riding in tandem criminals;
- (2) SANIB-PWERSA, a volunteer program that involved the actual participation of the community in crime prevention operations;
- (3) BANDO, a project that advertised the positive changes that were happening in the PNP through available mediums, to improve the image of the police to the community;
- (4) PAPA BEAR which was aimed to alleviate the distress caused by ill-fated events to children;

- (5) PULIS NIÑO, a project geared towards awareness of children in all causes of injury, which can either be intentional or unintentional;
- (6) SELFIE, the use of camera as a tool in responding to the call of the PNP in its mandate of protecting the people and in maintaining peace and order in the community; and
- (7) RUBIO COP, the use of a station mascot that serves as the PNP's "ambassador of goodwill;"

WHEREAS, Police Chief Inspector Ryan Lopez Manongdo led many successful peace-keeping operations in Pangasinan: (1) identification of the guilty parties in a school-based robbery in Region 1; (2) arrest of *budol-budol* gang members and recovery of 300 thousand pesos; (3) arrest of rogue cop turned gun-for-hire; (4) intensified campaign against loose firearms during the May 2013 elections; (5) intensified campaign against illegal drugs in Pozorrubio, Pangasinan; (6) arrest of top drug personality in Pozorrubio, Pangasinan;


WHEREAS, Police Chief Inspector Ryan Lopez Manongdo, in his ten-year-service as a police officer, has exhibited his commitment to his calling: protecting the weak; defending the innocents, and; advocating human rights. As such, he has become a source of inspiration to his colleagues, his Pangasinan provincemates and his fellow Dagupeños. His achievements deserve to be congratulated and commended for the honor and pride it has brought to Dagupan City;

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives extends its congratulations to all the COPS honourees, including: Police Superintendent Jemuel Felongco Siason of Sultan Kudarat Police Provincial Office (Tacurong City, Sultan Kudarat); Police Senior Superintendent Susan Rabano Jalla of PNP Crime Laboratory (Camp Crame, Quezon City); and Police Superintendent Mario Navarro Rariza, Jr. of Police Community Relations Group (Camp Crame, Quezon City); Police Officer 2 Fatima Peñones Ibias-Lanuza of Minalabac Municipal Police Station (Minalabac, Camarines Sur); Police Officer 3 Nida Lachica Gregas of Aklan Provincial Police Office (Numancia, Aklan); Senior Police Officer 1 Mhay Mayuyo Rubio of Bataan Police Provincial Office (Balanga City, Bataan); Senior Police Officer 2 Jeffrey Bayotlang Ojao of Cabadbaran Police Station 5 (Cabadbaran City, Agusan del Norte); Senior Police Officer 3 Hamidhan Bibio Tebbeng of PNP Anti-Kidnapping Group Mindanao Field Unit (Camp Gen Eduardo Batalla, Zamboanga City); and Senior Police Officer 3 Ezrael Domingo Lantingan of Alabel Municipal Station (Alabel, Saranggani Province);

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives extends its commendation to the Metrobank Foundation Inc. (MBFI), the Rotary Club of New Manila East (RCNME) and the Philippine Savings Bank (PSBank) for undertaking the annual search and reconition program;
