HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1619

RESOLUTION

EARNESTLY URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (DA)'S LEADERSHIP TO PROVIDE RELEVANT INFORMATION REGARDING ITS PRESENT AND FUTURE PHILIPPINE RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS (PRDPs) TO THE RESPECTIVE DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH LUZON TO ENSURE COHESIVE TEAM EFFORT OF ALL THOSE CONCERN IN ITS IMPLEMENTATION

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture (DA) is a Philippine government agency responsible for the promotion of agricultural development by providing framework, public investments, and support services needed for domestic and export-oriented business enterprises;

WHEREAS, the Government of the Philippines (GOP) thru a World Bank Loan has started a six-year (2014- 2020) Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP) designed to establish the government platform for modern, climate-resilient and market-oriented agri-fishery sector;


WHEREAS, the PRDP partners with provincial/district, city/municipal government units and the private sector in providing key infrastructures, facilities, technology, and information that will raise incomes, productivity, and competitiveness in the countryside;

WHEREAS, in the light of the regular DA infrastructure programs and i-Build component of the PRDP of which eligible sub-projects such as construction or rehabilitation of farm-to-market roads and bridges, communal irrigation systems, potable water systems, fishery-related infrastructures and other production and post-harvest facilities all must be cleared to avoid funding of the same project under different program;


