RESOLUTION NO. 169

RESOLUTION ENJOINING ALL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES TO AFFIRM THEIR COMMITMENT AND SUPPORT TO FACILITATE THE REBUILDING OF THE CITIES, MUNICIPALITIES, AND BARANGAYS IN REGIONS 1, 2, AND THE CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION (CAR) SEVERELY AFFECTED BY TYPHOON OMPONG IN SEPTEMBER 2018 AND TO IMMEDIATELY ADDRESS OPERATIONAL CONCERNS ON INFRASTRUCTURE, AGRI-INDUSTRY, AND SOCIAL ENGINEERING

WHEREAS, the North Luzon Growth Quadrangle, as the Philippines' single economic grouping of the northernmost regions in the country, namely: Region 1 (Ilocos and Pangasinan); Region 2 (Cagayan Valley); and the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), is being promoted as an investment destination for agribusiness, and human capital and tourism development;

WHEREAS, with the economic integration of Regions 1, 2, and the CAR, North Luzon's provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays are the ultimate beneficiaries of the expected development in infrastructure, agri-industry, and social engineering;

WHEREAS, among the benefits to be derived from the economic integration include the timely implementation of public sector programs and projects which include big-ticket projects listed in the respective region's investment programs, and better delivery of basic and emergency services to the constituents;

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives Special Committee on North Luzon Growth Quadrangle (NLGQ) serves as the venue for the legislative district representatives and the project implementors of the national and local governments to identify, address, and resolve issues on the identification, funding, and implementation of programs and projects as well as the delivery of basic and emergency services for the citizens;

WHEREAS, the Special Committee on NLGQ has determined through various consultations, inspections and hearings that in the aftermath of Typhoon Ompong which directly hit the NLGQ area, there remains a great need to strengthen the coordination and cooperation between and among government agencies, including those at the local government level, that perform crucial roles in the rebuilding process: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the House of Representatives, To enjoin all government agencies to affirm their commitment and support to facilitate the rebuilding of the cities, municipalities, and barangays in Regions 1, 2, and the Cordillera Administrative

Region (CAR) severely affected by Typhoon Ompong in September 2018 and to immediately address operational concerns on infrastructure, agri-ndustry, and social engineering.
