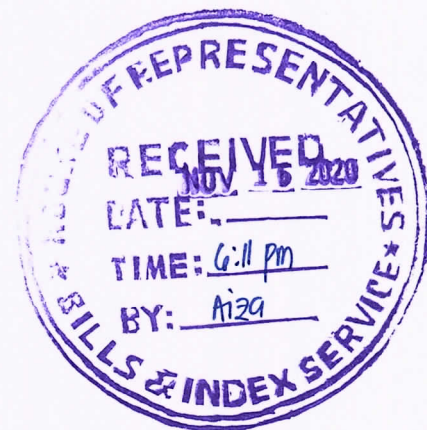

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This measure simply seeks to extend the effectivity of Republic Act No. 11494, the reason for which is to allow for the entirety of the allocated funds under the Bayanihan 2 to be fully downloaded to the respective agencies tasked to implement programs with it.

Extending the deadline from December 19, 2020 to January 31, 2021 is considered sufficient time to wrap up the transfer of funds. With this generous extension, we ensure that Bayanihan 2 will be utilized the way it was originally intended.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate approval of this measure is earnestly sought.





AN ACT
EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVITY OF BAYANIHAN 2 AMENDING FOR THIS
PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11494 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BAYANIHAN
TO RECOVER AS ONE ACT

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled,

1 **SECTION 1.** Section 18 of R.A. No, 11494 or the Bayanihan to Recover as One Act is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 “SEC. 18. *Effectivity.* – Except as otherwise specifically provided herein, this Act
5 shall be in full force and effect until [the next adjournment of the Eighteenth
6 Congress on December 19, 2020] **JANUARY 31, 2021**. This Act shall take effect
7 immediately upon its publication in a newspaper of general circulation or in the
8 *Official Gazette: Provided, That* Section 4 (cc) of this Act shall be deemed to be in
9 effect since Republic Act No. 11469 expired.”

10 **SEC. 2. *Repealing Clause.*** – All laws, decrees, executive orders or parts thereof
11 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

12 **SEC. 3. *Separability Clause.*** – If any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or
13 unconstitutional, the other parts not otherwise affected shall remain in full effect and force.

14 **SEC. 4. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect immediately upon approval.
