AN ACT

ESTABLISHING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MIGUEL, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, A SEPARATE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE FOR THE SECOND DISTRICT OF ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR TO BE KNOWN AS THE ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR – SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE II, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** There is hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of
2 Education (DepEd), a Schools Division Office in the Municipality of San Miguel, Province of
3 Zamboanga del Sur to be known as the Zamboanga del Sur – Schools Division Office II.

5 The Zamboanga del Sur – Schools Division Office II shall have jurisdiction over all
6 basic education schools in the following municipalities of the Second District, Zamboanga del
7 Sur: Municipalities of Bayog, Dimataling, Dinas, Dumalinao, Kumalarang, Lakewood,
8 Lapuyan, Margosatubig, Pitogo, San Miguel, San Pablo, Tabina, Tigbao, Vincenzo A. Sagun,
9 and Guipos.

11 The DepEd shall determine the staff complement and the qualification standards of the
12 personnel assigned at the Zamboanga del Sur – Schools Division Office II.

14 **SEC. 2.** The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's
15 program the operationalization of the Zamboanga del Sur – Schools Division Office II, the
16 funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

18 **SEC. 3.** Within ninety (90) days after the approval of this Act, the Secretary of
19 Education shall promulgate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

21 **SEC. 4.** All laws, orders, and rules and regulations contrary to, or inconsistent with, the
22 provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

24 **SEC. 5.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
25 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
