**WHEREAS**, Mr. Daniel “Danny” Morales Javier, famously known as Danny Javier, of the legendary Filipino musical trio APO Hiking Society passed away on October 31, 2022 at the age of 75;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Danny Javier was born on August 6, 1947 in Abuyog, Leyte. He studied at the San Beda College and Ateneo de Manila University.

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Danny Javier coined the term Original Pilipino Music (OPM), referring to a popular genre of music which now covers all popular music composed and performed by Filipino artists;

**WHEREAS**, among his renowned compositions are “Show Me A Smile” (1976), “Pag-ibig” (1978), “Pumapatak ang Ulan” (1978), “Kaibigan” (1978), “Doo bidoo” (1978), “Kabilugan ng Buwan” (1980), “Blue Jeans” (1981), “Di Na Natuto” (1985), “Kumot at Unan” (1991), “Awit ng Barkada” (1991), “Just A Smile Away” (1992), “Lumang Tugtugin” (1992), “Isang Dangkal” (1999);

**WHEREAS**, the celebrated and multi-awarded Apo Hiking Society have released more than 27 albums and hundreds of songs over a career spanning some 40 years;

**WHEREAS**, his team-up with fellow Apo Hiking Society members Jim Paredes and Boboy Garrovillo produced several popular shows on television such as the long-running “Sa Linggo nAPO Sila” on ABS-CBN;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Danny Javier assumed a popular fictitious character as “Pidro,” a probinsiyano who went to Manila seeking good fortune. The character was such a hit that he ventured into a T-shirt business with Pidro images;

**WHEREAS**, he was a musician, singer, composer, actor, television host, and businessman;

**WHEREAS**, his life and legacy have carved a profound niche in the entertainment industry. Mr. Danny Javier will continue to become an inspiration to young musicians today and many generations to come.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the House of Representatives expresses its profound sympathy and sincere condolences to the family of Mr. Danny Javier who, through his dedication and passion, have been an integral part of Filipino music and entertainment;

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the bereaved family of the late Mr. Danny Javier.


