**A RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE 33 AWARDEES  
OF THE 2023 ANI NG DANGAL AWARDS**

**WHEREAS**, Ani ng Dangal or "Harvest of Honors" is an organizational award given by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts. It is an annual event in the country celebrated as a highlight and concluding rite of the Philippine Arts Festival;

**WHEREAS**, Ani ng Dangal is given to natural-born Filipino artists or groups that has reaped top honors in international events which includes the seven art disciplines Architecture and Allied Arts, Cinema, Dance, Dramatic Arts, Literary Arts, Music, Visual Arts as well as Multi-Disciplinary Arts;

**WHEREAS**, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) awarded 33 groups and individuals at this year's Ani ng Dangal Awards, with several of the recipients attending a special ceremony at Malacañan Palace;<sup>1</sup>

**WHEREAS**, this year's 15th Ani ng Dangal Awards saw 11 awardees for cinema, 10 for music, 4 for dance, another 4 for architecture and allied arts, and 3 for visual arts and a sole recipient for broadcast arts;

**WHEREAS**, awardees from cinema include actors such as **Dolly de Leon** who won Best Supporting Performer for "Triangle of Sadness" at the Los Angeles Film Critics Association Awards (LAFCA) in 2022; **Jeric Gonzales**, who won Best Actor for "Broken Blooms" at the Harlem International Film Festival in New York in 2022; **Gerlado B. Jumawan**, who won Best Actor in the Short Film category for "The Glance" at the 10th LakeCity International Film Festival in India in 2022; and **Joaquin Domagoso** who won Best Actor for "That Boy in the Dark" at the Toronto Film and Script Awards (16th edition) in Toronto, Canada in 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the Ani Ng Dangal Award were given to notable films like "**Di N'yo Ba Naririnig**" directed by Elvin Jay Macanlalay which won the Golden Kinabalu Award for Best Documentary and "**The Flight of Banog**" directed by Elvert Bañares, which won the Golden Kinabalu Award for Best Indigenous Language Film, both at the 13th Kota Kinabalu International Film Festival in Malaysia in 2022; "**Leonor Will Never Die**" for World Cinema Dramatic Special Jury for Innovative Spirit Award in the 2022 Sundance Film Festival, "**Black Rainbow**" directed by Zig Dulay, Best Short Film at the LUCAS International Festival for Young Film Lovers in Frankfurt, Germany in 2022, "**The HeadHunter's Daughter**" directed by Don Josephus Raphael Eblahan, Grand Jury Prize for Short Film at the Sundance Film Festival in 2022, "**It's Raining Frogs Outside**" for an International Award, "**Days of the New**" for International Competition Grand Prix;

**WHEREAS**, in the music category, the Ani Ng Dangal Awardees are **Ryle Nicole Custudio**, who won the grand prize at the 2022 Busan Choral Competition for "**Tagu-Taguan**," and the **Far Eastern University Chorale**, who won first place in the mixed choir competition at the 2022 Andrea O. Veneracion International Choir Festival. **Danikka Louise Dy** was the grand prize winner at the Vocal Competition, Advanced (Very Competitive) Junior Category at the Rocky Mountain Music Competition Spring Season 2022. Other notable awardees in the music category are **Darwin J. Lomentigar**, who won First Place for Amateur Solo Vocal Classical Competition at the 10th Jean Sibelius International Solo Vocal Competition; **Rafael Adobas Bayog**, who won First Prize at the 10th Kobe International Flute Competition in Japan in March 2022; **Ily Matthew Maniano**, who won First Prize Composition Winner for "Amihan" at the Busan Choral Festival & Competition in South Korea in October 2022; **Theodore Julius Chua Tan**, who won First Place Winner in Judges' Best Performance Award for Junior Category Ages 9-12 – Violin at the Vienna Virtuoso Music Competition in 2022; **Adrik Cristobal**, who won First

Prize Open Category at the Thailand International Guitar Competition in Thailand in 2022; **Jeanne Rafaella Marquez** who won First Prize in Aaron Rosand Memorial Award Advanced (16-18) Category at the New York Young Performers Prize Competition in New York in 2022; and finally **Michael Valenciano** who won First Prize in Lucy Boyan Balakian Award College (19-23) Category at the New York Young Performers Prize Competition in New York in 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the dance recipients were led by "*Danse avec les stars*" winner **Billy Crawford** in France in November 2022; **ELECTRO GROOVERS**, that won the International Champion (Varsity Division) at the World Supremacy Battlegrounds in Australia in 2022; **Halili-Cruz School of Ballet** that won 1st Place for "Stage to Screen" at the Asia Pacific Dance Competition in Singapore in January 2021; and finally **Bayanihan (Philippines' National Folk Dance Company)** that won the Grand Prize at the Cheonan World Dance Festival in Korea in September 2022;

**WHEREAS**, two of the architecture and allied arts were winners at the 2022 Iconic Awards in Germany, Jorge Yulo Architects & Associates' "*Equilateral House*" as Winner for Innovative Architecture and WTA Architecture and Design Studio's "*Batangas Forest City*" as Best for Innovative Architecture (Master Planning Category), both at the Iconic Awards in Germany in 2022. The other two are Atelier Almario's "*The Penthouse*" which won Best Residential Interior Apartment at the Asia Pacific Property Awards in United Kingdom in April 2022 and Chat Fores Design Studio's "*The Galleon Residences Showroom*" which won Best Residential Show Home at the Asia Pacific Region at the 2021 International Property Awards;

**WHEREAS**, the three visual arts recipients were **Albert Emir Reyes** for his "*Bustling Little Town*" winning the grand prize at the 23rd International High School Arts Festival in Tokyo, Japan; **Froiland Rivera** for his "*Online Learning*" winning the first prize at the 2021 Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation Photo Contest; and **Mariah Karla Zamora** who was a national award winner at the Sony World Photography Awards in London in February 2022;

**WHEREAS**, the lone awardee in the Broadcast Arts category is "*A Thousand Cuts*", a film by Romana Diaz that won Outstanding Social Issue Documentary at the 43rd News and Documentary Emmy Awards on September 2022;

**WHEREAS**, all 33 recipients of the Ani ng Dangal were given stylized sarimanok trophies sculpted by National Artist for Visual Arts Abdulmari Imao;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that taking into consideration the above mentioned premises, we, the undersigned members of the House of Representatives congratulate and commend the 33 awardees of the 2023 Ani Ng Dangal Awards;

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that an appropriate copy of this resolution be given to all the awardees of the 2023 Ani Ng Dangal Awards mentioned and another copy be prepared for submission to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines for proper archiving.


