WHEREAS, the country mourns the passing of renowned Filipino designer Mr. Pepito De Leon Albert on 27 May 2023 at the age of 64;

WHEREAS, Mr. Pepito Albert developed his talents by attending the Fashion Institute of Design and Merchandising in Los Angeles, California thereupon returning to the Philippines in the 1990s designing the most regal outfits for prominent people in the political and social sphere. His works were featured in big fashion bibles, such as Vogue, Harper’s Bazaar, Elle, and W. From then on, he was known for being the classic designer of fashion elites, A-list celebrities, socialites, politicians, and other industry leaders;

WHEREAS, Mr. Pepito Albert was one of the few veteran designers who consistently used local fabrics and techniques and incorporated Filipino culture and art into his designs thereby paving the way for many of the country's designers to weave our national identity into modern fashion;

WHEREAS, Mr. Pepito Albert was esteemed, celebrated, and loved by his friends and contemporaries in the fashion industry regarding him as a true fashion genius with a big heart;

WHEREAS, Mr. Pepito Albert's legacy and contributions to the Filipino fashion industry will be highly revered as inspiration to his contemporaries and to the next generation of young designers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the House of Representatives expresses its profound sympathy and sincere condolences to the family of Mr. Pepito Albert, who is remembered for revolutionizing the Filipino fashion industry;






