**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE DEEP CONDOLENCES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON THE PASSING OF VETERAN BROADCAST JOURNALIST Miguel ‘Mike’ Castro ENRIQUEZ**

**WHEREAS**, the country mourns the passing of veteran broadcast journalist Miguel ‘Mike’ Castro Enriquez on August 29, 2023;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Enriquez was born in September 1951. He took up Liberal Arts in Commerce at De La Salle University and graduated in 1973;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Mike Enriquez served as a broadcast journalist for 54 years;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Mike Enriquez began his career in radio broadcasting in 1969 as a staff announcer for the Manila Broadcasting Co. when he was still a student at De La Salle

University. He then proceeded to work for various Radio Networks as a reporter, editor, program director, and vice president of Radio Mindanao Network until 1994;<sup>1</sup>

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Enriquez first appeared on National Television as a news anchor covering the 1998 elections. Since his debut, he has been host for TV programs which include Saksi, GMA Network News, Imbestigador, and 24 oras. He also hosted radio programs such as Saksi sa Dobol B via Super Radyo DZBB;<sup>2</sup>

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Enriquez is a recipient of many awards for his contribution to Philippine Mass Media from national and international award giving bodies. Among his notable awards are 1999 Golden Dove Award for Best Male Newscaster and of the Ka Doroy Valencia Broadcaster of the Year Award given by the Kapisanan Ng Mga Brodkaster ng Pilipinas (KBP), first Filipino to win the Best Newscaster Award in the Asian Television held in Singapore, his team won the Silver Camera Award in the 2004 US Film and Video Festival for the documentary "Iraq: In the Naval War";<sup>3</sup>

**WHEREAS**, The passing of Mr. Enriquez is a great loss to the nation. He served as an inspiration to mass media practitioners and the Filipino mass for his unwavering service and commitment in delivering Philippine news and current affairs;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the House of Representatives expresses its profound sympathy and sincere condolences to the family of Mr. Miguel 'Mike' Castro Enriquez, who is remembered for his service in delivering news and public affairs to the Filipino people and his contributions to Philippine Mass Media;

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the bereaved family of the late Mr. Miguel 'Mike' Castro Enriquez.






