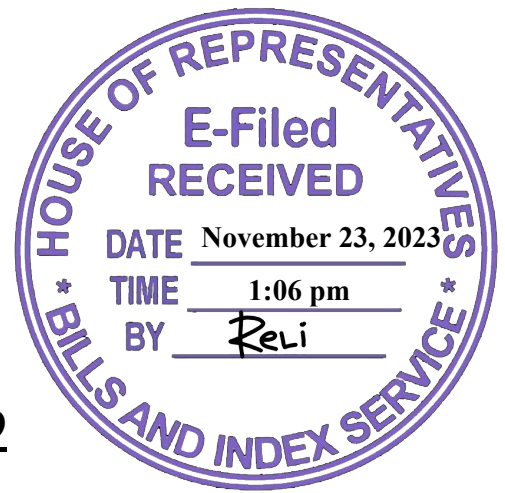

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE DEEP CONDOLENCES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ON THE PASSING OF VETERAN JOURNALIST RINA JIMENEZ-DAVID

WHEREAS, the country mourns the passing of veteran journalist and women's rights advocate Rina Jimenez-David on 12 November 2023 at the age of 68;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rina Jimenez-David joined the Inquirer in 1988, where she wrote the column "At Large" for nearly three decades before her retirement in 2021. She was best known for her columns tackling women's health issues and challenging politicians on the country's most pressing issues;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rina Jimenez-David was an honored journalist being a recipient of multiple awards. She was twice named as Best Columnist for Excellence by the Global Media Awards in 1994 and 2004. In 2015, she was honored by Woman Delivered, a global advocacy organization, as one of 15 journalists worldwide who use their voices and media platforms to bring attention to significant issues affecting girls and women. She was likewise awarded the People Management Association of the Philippines Makatao Awards in 2019;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rina Jimenez-David wrote books such as "Woman at Large," a compilation of her columns from 1989 to 1994 which became a finalist in the National Book Awards in 1994, and "Nightmare Journeys," which told the stories of women survivors of trafficking;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rina Jimenez-David's conscientious voice against prevailing inequalities that marginalize women drew national recognition with a TOWNS (The Outstanding Women in the Nation's Service) Award for Women's Rights Advocacy in 1995;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rina Jimenez-David, as former national chair of the feminist group Pilipina, likewise received a fellowship at the Johns Hopkins University School of Public Health in Baltimore, Maryland;


