**CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING MARIKINA CITY FOOTWEAR DESIGNERS MR. CHAD GABRIELLE TANUTAN, MS. MA. DANIELLA LOUISE BORRERO, MR. IVAN FABIA, AND MS. LEE VILLANUEVA FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS AT THE 13TH INTERNATIONAL FOOTWEAR DESIGN COMPETITION HELD IN GUANGZHOU CITY, CHINA, ON MAY 29, 2024**

1           WHEREAS, the 13th International Footwear Design Competition was held  
2 on May 29, 2024, in Yuexiu District, Guangzhou City, China, organized by the  
3 Confederation of International Footwear Association, a coalition of 17 footwear  
4 associations across Asia;

6           WHEREAS, the competition showcased exceptional talent and creativity in  
7 footwear design, highlighting innovative and artistic contributions from  
8 participants around the world;

9  
10           WHEREAS, the representatives from Marikina City demonstrated  
11 exemplary skills and craftsmanship during the competition, successfully earning  
12 top honors in various categories, thus bringing pride and recognition to the city  
13 and the country;

14  
15           WHEREAS, Mr. Chad Gabrielle Tanutan won the top designer award in the  
16 Men’s Shoe Individual category for his “Ligum Dulom,” which symbolizes hope  
17 emerging from darkness;

18  
19           WHEREAS, Ms. Ma. Daniella Louise Borrero received the 2nd Runner-Up  
20 award in the Men’s Shoe Individual category with her “Tusok-Tusok,” design,  
21 which honors a Filipino culinary street food subculture;

2 WHEREAS, Mr. Ivan Fabia won the top award in the Lady’s Boot  
3 Individual category for his design named “Juana”, representing powerful  
4 femininity with intricate play of local materials and symbolic elements;

6 WHEREAS, Ms. Lee Villanueva won two 1st Runner-Up awards, in the  
7 Lady’s Boot Individual category with the design named “Bulawan”, which  
8 celebrates the use of gold in Philippine ornamentation from pre-Hispanic times to  
9 the present, and in the Lady’s Trend Individual category, with the design named  
10 “Kaibahan”, inspired by the diversity and craft heritage of Filipino ethnic groups;

12 WHEREAS, these Marikina footwear designers were previously part of the  
13 top finalists in the Footwear Design Making category during the 9th Filipino  
14 Footwear Design Competition 2023, themed “PAA-HON: Championing Filipino  
15 Culture and Heritage”;

17 WHEREAS, the exceptional performance of these Marikina footwear  
18 designers exemplifies the rich heritage and unparalleled tradition of shoe  
19 craftsmanship in the city, renowned as the Shoe Capital of the Philippines;

21 WHEREAS, the honor and prestige brought home by these Marikina  
22 footwear designers serve as inspiration to young shoe designers of Marikina City  
23 as well as artists and designers in the creative industries of the country to exploit  
24 our Filipino culture and traditions in creating works of art even for the global  
25 market: Now, therefore, be it
