WHEREAS, the La MaMa Experimental Theatre Club is an off-off Broadway theater established in 1961, dedicated to the artist and all aspects of theatre;

WHEREAS, La MaMa held its "Remake-a-World" Gala last 10 November 2022 in New York City;

WHEREAS, Ms. Cecile Guidote-Alvarez was the only Southeast Asian honored in the said event, for her work as a global citizen dedicated to "cultural caregiving", thereby transforming her local community and beyond;

WHEREAS, La MaMa Theater recognized Ms. Guidote-Alvarez's significant contribution in the arts, as founder of the Philippine Educational Theater Association, and her free arts training to street children, the disabled, and indigenous youth";

WHEREAS, Ms. Guidote-Alvarez directed the Third World Institute of Theater Arts Studies at the La MaMa Theater, showcasing Asia-Africa and Latin

America's cultural diversity as they relate to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, even as she served the Filipino-American community through the Philippine Educational Theater Arts League: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the House of Representatives, To commend Ms. Cecile Guidote-Alvarez for being the only Southeast Asian Awardee at La Mama Theater's 'Remake A World Gala' in New York City;
