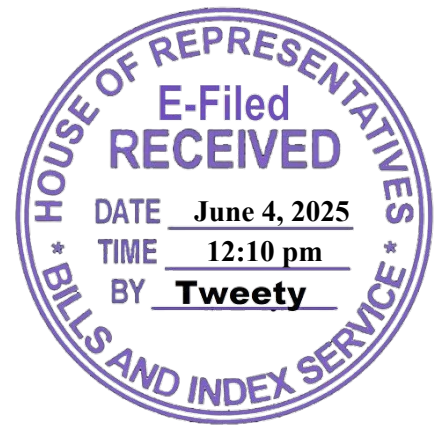

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING PROFOUND CONDOLENCES ON THE PASSING OF NORA AUNOR, NATIONAL ARTIST FOR FILM AND BROADCAST ARTS, AND HONORING HER UNPARALLELED CONTRIBUTIONS TO PHILIPPINE CINEMA AND CULTURE

WHEREAS, Nora Cabaltera Villamayor, professionally known as Nora Aunor, passed away on April 16, 2025, at the age of 71, leaving behind an enduring legacy as one of the most revered and influential figures in the history of Philippine entertainment;

WHEREAS, born to an impoverished family in Iriga City, Camarines Sur, Nora Aunor overcame early hardships—selling water at a train station in her youth—before rising to fame as a teenage singing sensation in the 1960s, captivating the nation with her powerful and soulful voice;

WHEREAS, Nora Aunor’s transition to acting led to a prolific career that spanned seven decades, with over 200 film and television credits to her name, including numerous masterpieces that have become foundational works in Philippine cinema;

WHEREAS, Nora Aunor delivered unforgettable performances in landmark films such as *Tatlong Taong Walang Diyos* (1976), *Bulaklak sa City Jail* (1984), *The Flor Contemplacion Story* (1995), and *Andrea, Paano ba ang Maging Isang Ina?* (1990), for which she swept all major best actress awards in the country—a rare feat known as a grand slam;

WHEREAS, Nora Aunor internationally acclaimed portrayal of a midwife in *Thy Womb* (2012) earned her the Best Actress award at the prestigious Asian Film Awards, further affirming her global stature as a consummate artist;

WHEREAS, breaking barriers with her petite frame and dusky features in an industry then dominated by Western standards, Nora Aunor redefined the archetype of the Filipino leading lady and gave voice and visibility to the lives and struggles of ordinary Filipinos through her deeply human performances;

WHEREAS, Nora Aunor remained active in the entertainment industry until her final years, most recently starring in the film *Mananambal* (2024) and appearing in the television series *Lilet Matias, Attorney-at-Law*, demonstrating her enduring relevance and dedication to her craft;

WHEREAS, in recognition of her unparalleled contribution to Philippine arts and culture, Nora Aunor was named National Artist for Film and Broadcast Arts in 2022, the highest national distinction for Filipino artists;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that we express our profound condolence on the passing of Nora Aunor, National Artist and beloved Superstar, and pay tribute to her immense cultural legacy and lifelong dedication to the Filipino people through music, film, and television;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be presented to the family of Nora Aunor as a symbol of the nation's deepest sympathy and enduring gratitude.


