A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SINCEREST AND PROFOUND GRATITUDE AND APPRECIATION TO SAGIP PELIKULA FOR ITS OUTSTANDING LEGACY IN FILIPINO FILM RESTORATION

WHEREAS, the ABS-CBN Film Restoration Project, also known as Sagip Pelikula, was launched in 2011 as a digital film restoration project of ABS-CBN Corporation in partnership with Central Digital Lab;

WHEREAS, Sagip Pelikula served as the pioneering film restoration arm of ABS-CBN, with the mission of digitally restoring and remastering selected Filipino films from the extensive archives of ABS-CBN;

WHEREAS, after nearly 14 years of dedicated service to Philippine culture and the arts, Sagip Pelikula ceased its operations on 31 March 2025, having successfully scanned, enhanced, restored, remastered, and reintroduced over 240 Filipino films to new generations of audiences;

WHEREAS, Sagip Pelikula restored a wide array of films across diverse genres and historical periods—from prewar titles to contemporary classics—ensuring that invaluable cinematic works were preserved for posterity;

WHEREAS, Sagip Pelikula helped restore Filipino films into a 1080p or 2K Digital Cinema Package format with a maximum resolution of 2048x1080 pixels at 24 frames per second. These films have been released through a wide array of platforms including limited theatrical runs, film

festivals, free-to-air and cable television, DVDs, pay-per-view, and over-the-top content platforms such as iTunes.

WHEREAS, the project came full circle with the restoration of “**Himala**” directed by National Artist Ishmael Bernal as its debut effort, and the premiere of Mario O’Hara’s “**Tatlong Ina, Isang Anak**” as its final film restoration before ceasing operations, both of which starred the late National Artist Nora Aunor;

WHEREAS, among the prominent restorations of Sagip Pelikula were Peque Gallaga’s “**Oro, Plata, Mata**” (1982), Eddie Romero’s “**Ganito Kami Noon, Paano Kayo Ngayon?**” (1976), Chito S. Roño’s “**Dekada ’70**” (2002), Laurice Guillen’s “**Tanging Yaman**” (2000), Mike de Leon’s “**Kakabakaba Ka Ba?**” (1980), O’Hara’s “**Tatlong Taong Walang Diyos**” (1976), Marilou Diaz-Abaya’s “**Karnal**” (1983) and “**Moral**” (1982), Rory B. Quintos’ “**Anak**” (2000), Gil Portes’ “**Markova: Comfort Gay**” (2000) and Vicente Salumbides’ “**Ibong Adarna**” (1941);

WHEREAS, by passing this Resolution, Sagip Pelikula is recognized and celebrated for its dedication and effort in the restoration of Filipino films, bringing to light the brilliance of Filipino filmmakers, actors, and storytellers;






